

The National Club


The Propeller Club of the United States is a grassroots, non-profit organization, dedicated to the enhancement and well-being of all interests of the maritime community on a national and international basis.





Port Activities

Essay Contest

Each year in selected schools, The Port sponsors an essay contest meant to increase awareness of the industry and spotlight the local maritime-related industry. The three winners, first, second and third, receive award certificates and savings bonds.



Angel Tree

During the holiday season, members are encouraged to gather toys and bring them, new and unwrapped, to the December meeting where they will be forwarded to the Salvation Army for distribution as part of the annual Angel Tree program.

The Jason Foundation

The Port's primary community service activity involves participation in the work of the Jason Foundation, (JFI).

JFI is a nationally recognized provider of educational curricula and training programs for students/educators/youth workers and parents. The programs are meant to develop a greater awareness of the national health problem of youth suicide.

The Jason Foundation was founded in Nashville in 1997 in response to the loss of a 16 year old student. It is intended to provide information, tools and resources to confront this "silent epidemic" and prevent the tragedy of youth suicide.

Annual Golf Tournament

The Port's annual golf tournament and associated auction of sports-themed and other items is dedicated to the support of JFI which now has over 55 offices in 26 states.
